A research team led by Research Fellow Zhu Xingjiang from the Department of Physics, Faculty of Arts and Sciences, and the Gravitational Waves and Cosmology Laboratory at BNU, in collaboration with international astronomers, has successfully discovered a pulsar located in the direction of the ancient open cluster NGC 6791 using the Five-hundred-meter Aperture Spherical radio Telescope (FAST). The pulsar, designated as PSR J1922+37, rotates once every 1.9 seconds. This discovery marks a significant advancement in the study of open clusters. The findings were recently published in *The Astrophysical Journal Letters (ApJL)*, with Dr. Liu Xiaojin from the Department of Physics as the first author and Research Fellow Zhu Xingjiang as the corresponding author.




